- Meeting Commenced: 6:35pm, Sept 27th, 2023
- Keynote speaker: RJ Jones
 - RJ Jones is Saulteaux–Cree, originally from Treaty 1 territory in Saskatchewan and is living on Algonquin Territory in Ottawa. He is a Two Spirit, Non-Binary, and Queer multimedia artist and educator. RJ is an experienced facilitator and has been invited to give workshops and keynotes across Canada. RJ's passion for learning, 2SLGBTQIA+ advocacy, and sexual health have been foundational in seeking ways to build partnerships and bridges between 2SLGBTQIA+ organizations and Indigenous organizations.

 - Breakdown of present voting members: 14 voting members present in person, 1 by proxy

 - Assets this year are lower than last year, largely due to decrease in the deferred revenue
 - Significant decrease in donations, mainly due to large donation received from TD Bank last year

 - Peer Support Helpline
 - Increase in demand during pandemic with more intense needs from Youth – mental health + isolation and peer/partner/family relationships
 - Ending the phone line in May 2022
 - 4,000+ contacts this year
 - 69 amazing volunteers 62% BIPCO, 48% Trans, 8% Norther/Rural
 - Very positive user feedback!!!
 - Peer Support Priorities for 2023-2024
 - Strengthening volunteers supports and providing more opportunities for continuous learning and community engagement
 - Collaborating with other orgs for knowledge exchange
 - Broadening the helpline's reach and recruiting a more representative volunteer cohort
 - Furthering accessibility of our resource and referral databases
 - Learning, Grounding, Growing
 - Mental health workshop series for Toronto youth with many volunteers participating as well
 - Online Learning
 - Revamping our training and shift resources with OTF fund
 - Lots of new modules developed for volunteers, staff, and board members – interactive, accessible, includes break reminders and self-care guide



- Also developed: Trans Health for Youth 18 and Under, Safety Planning and Emergency housing, and Supporting 2S Youth Navigating Traditional Spaces
- Youth Organize
 - 31 participants in total!
 - 2 drop in spaces held, 7 active YAC members, 1 workshop completed
- PYAP
 - Changed the staffing structure with two new positions
 - Created some amazing digital media products, videos, podcasts, and presentation
 - Program has sadly come to an end, still working on ways to continue providing support
- Intro to Lauren Pragg (Interim ED)
 - Has been with YouthLine since March 2023
 - Previously worked at YouthLine in 2018-2019
 - Lots of change within the past year thank you to staff and volunteers for keeping
 - Successful pride campaign due to Board-staff collaboration
 - Future plans to implement strategic planning recommendations and invest in northern, rural, and Indigenous communities
