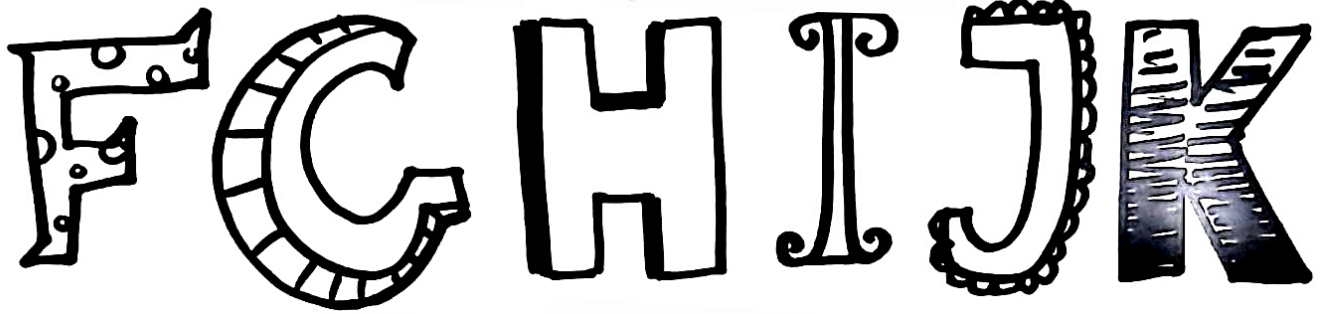


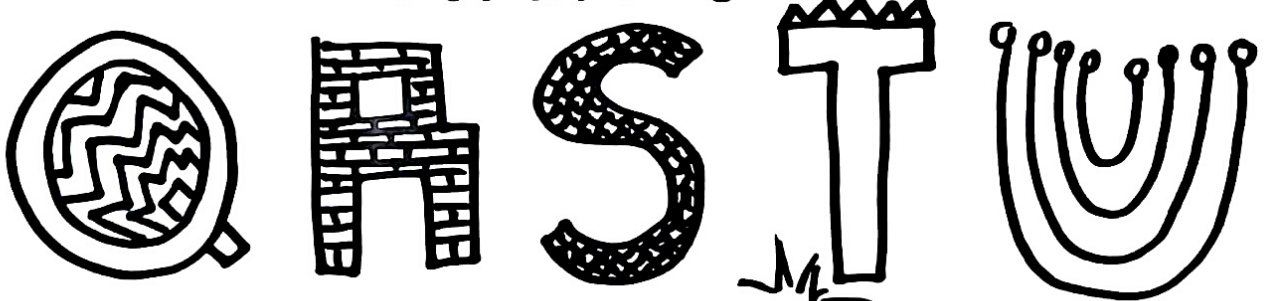

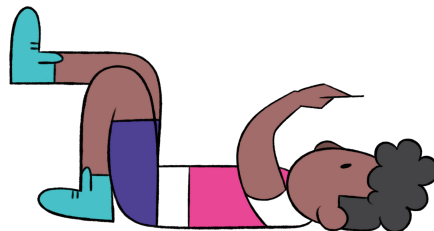
- (1) Providing anonymous peer support and referrals

Everyone is different and that should be celebrated!

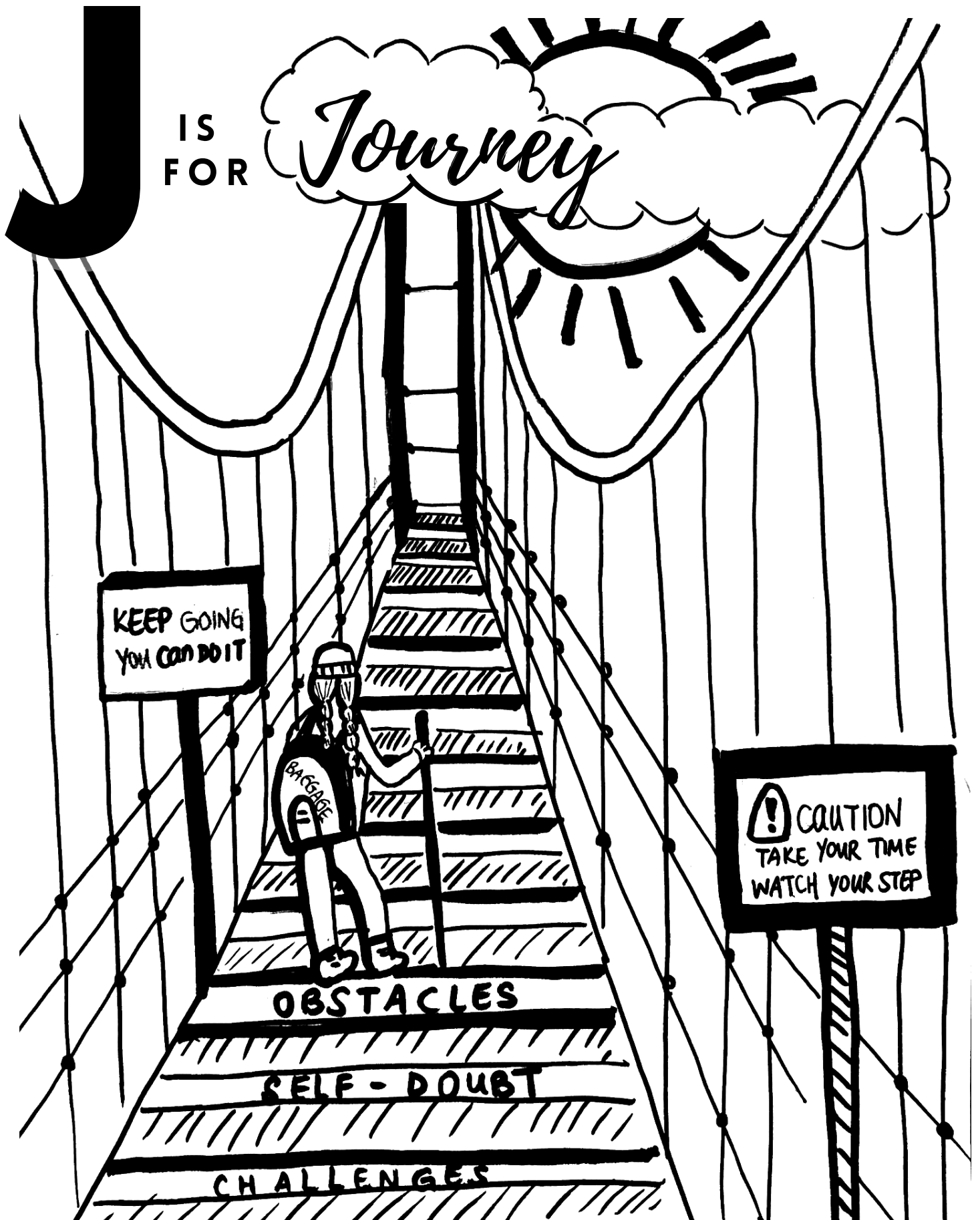
Intersectionality looks at the ways that different identities intersect to create unique privileges, power dynamics, and systems of oppression.
